



**SURFACE WATER MONITORING/REPORTING VIOLATION  
Announcement/Publication**

The **CITY OF CAMP WOOD WATER SYSTEM**, PWS ID **TX1930001**, has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems that treat surface water and/or ground water under the direct influence of surface water are required to submit monthly operating reports with operational data of the water provided to their customers.

Due to the resignation of the City of Camp Wood Water Operator we failed to provide and/or report the monitoring **MONTHLY OPERATING REPORT** to the following constituents, **TCEQ**.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period of **JULY 2014**.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe. We did not complete all reporting for surface water constituents, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

**All outstanding reports have been filed and submitted to TCEQ as required.**
